Nomination Criteria

Students Criteria: 14- to 16-year-old (born between 2008 and 2010)

Deadline for nomination: 26 April 2024, Friday

Things to note:

1. Candidates must be born between 2008 and 2010, 14- to 16-year-old for admission to Year 3 in Academic Year 2025.
2. All nominated candidates applying for School-Based-Scholarship are required to submit their particulars and upload scanned copy of birth certificate / identity card (ID) / passport and past three years of school results via the URL <https://go.gov.sg/nush-ay2025-sbs-vietnam> by 26 April 2024.
3. Candidates are to bring along their identity card (IC) or identification documents or passport and place them at the top right corner of the desk for verification purposes during the test.
4. Calculators are not allowed for all tests.
5. All electronic devices are strictly prohibited during the test.
6. Only shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview.
7. Successful candidates must be accompanied by a surety for the contract signing occasion.
8. The Surety must satisfy the following conditions:
 - a. Be a Singapore Citizen (preferably) or a Vietnam national.
 - b. Be above 21 years but under 55 years of age (as of signing date for scholarship agreement) and gainfully employed.
 - c. Not be a bankrupt; and
 - d. Not be a party to an existing scholarship/bursary/study loan or any other Deed/Agreement.
